HOUSE BILL NO. 259

AN ACT TO REGULATE USE OF DRONES; TO PROVIDE DEFINITIONS; TO 1 2 PROHIBIT ANY PERSON FROM USING A DRONE TO CAPTURE UNAUTHORIZED 3 IMAGES; TO PROVIDE EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN IMAGES THAT ARE 4 CAPTURED; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and hereinafter referred to as the "Drone Prohibition Act." 8 SECTION 2. For purposes of this act, the following words 9 10 shall have the meaning ascribed herein unless the context shall otherwise require: 11 (a) "Image" means any capturing of sound waves, 12 13 thermal, infrared, ultraviolet, visible light, or other 14 electromagnetic waves, odor, or other conditions existing on or 15 about real property in this state or an individual located on that 16 property; and 17 (b) "Drone" means any unmanned airborne device that is operated without an individual in or on the device. 18

19 <u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Except as otherwise provided in this
20 section, it shall be unlawful for any person to capture an image
21 using a drone, as defined by this act.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shallnot apply to:

(a) Any person who is conducting professional or
scholarly research and development and acting on behalf of an
institution of higher learning, if such person is a professor,
employee, or student of the institution; or under contract with or
otherwise acting under the direction of or on behalf of the
institution;

30 (b) Any unmanned airborne device that is in airspace 31 designated as a test site or range authorized by the Federal 32 Aviation Administration for the purpose of integrating unmanned 33 aircraft systems into the national airspace;

34 (c) Any unmanned airborne device that is used as part
 35 of an operation, exercise, or mission of any branch of the United
 36 States military;

37 (d) Any image that is captured by a satellite for the38 purposes of mapping;

39 (e) Any image captured by or for an electric or natural40 gas utility:

(1) For the purpose of fire suppression;

70 (m) For the purpose of rescuing a person whose life or 71 well-being is in imminent danger;

(n) If the image is captured by a Mississippi licensed real estate broker in connection with the marketing, sale, or financing of real property, provided that no individual is identifiable in the image;

76 (o) Of public real property or a person on that 77 property;

(p) If the image is captured by the owner or operator of an oil, gas, water, or other pipeline for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, or repairing pipelines or other related facilities, and is captured without the intent to conduct surveillance on an individual or real property located in this state;

84 (q) In connection with oil and gas pipeline and well85 safety and protection;

86 (r) In connection with port authority surveillance and87 security; or

(s) An image captured by a state or local government agency, or by a person who is under contract with or otherwise acting under the direction or on behalf of such agency, and shall not be used for any purpose other than the lawful purpose for which the image was captured as permitted by this section.

93 SECTION 4. Any person violating the provisions of this act 94 shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or 95 imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both. Each image captured in violation of this act shall be a separate offense. 96 97 The amount of the fine for any subsequent violation of this act shall be no less than One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 98 99 (\$1,500.00). The time for imprisonment for any subsequent violation of this act shall be at least twelve (12) months in the 100 101 State Penitentiary.

102 <u>SECTION 5.</u> The provisions of this act shall apply unless 103 preempted by applicable federal law or by regulations adopted by 104 the Federal Aviation Administration.

105 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 106 and after July 1, 2022.
