HOUSE BILL NO. 321

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-20-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT THE CHILD CARE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL BE COMPRISED OF 3 MEMBERS THAT ARE APPOINTED BASED ON RECOMMENDATIONS FROM CHILD 4 CARE PROVIDERS THROUGHOUT THE STATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 43-20-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 43-20-7. (1) There is hereby created an advisory council 8 9 which shall be appointed by the State Health Officer, who shall 10 serve at the pleasure of the State Health Officer. The advisory council shall consist of twelve (12) 11 (2) persons, * * * who shall be appointed based on recommendations 12 13 from child care providers throughout the state. 14 (3) It shall be the duty of the advisory council to assist and advise the licensing agency in the development of regulations 15 governing the licensure and regulation of child care facilities 16 17 and to advise the licensing agency on matters relative to the administration and interpretation of the provisions of this 18 19 chapter. 20 (4) Members of the advisory council shall be reimbursed for21 mileage and expenses as is authorized by law.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after July 1, 2022.
