(2) Each justice and municipal court in this state shall 13 14 require all pleadings and other papers to be served, filed, signed or verified by electronic means in conformity with the Mississippi 15 Electronic Court System procedures by July 1, 2023. 16 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2022. 18
