COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 400

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF RIDING BAILIFFS; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 19-25-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 19-25-31. Each judge of a circuit, chancery or county court, or a court of eminent domain may, in the judge's discretion, by 8 9 order entered on the minutes of the court, allow the sheriff 10 riding bailiffs to serve in the respective court of such judge, 11 not to exceed four (4) bailiffs. Any such person so employed shall be paid by the county on allowances of the court on issuance 12 of a warrant therefor in an amount of *** * *** One Hundred Dollars 13 14 (\$100.00) for each day, or part thereof, for which he or she serves as bailiff when the court is in session. No full-time 15 16 deputy sheriff shall be paid as a riding bailiff of any court. 17 County court judges shall be limited to one (1) bailiff per each 18 court day.
