The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 128 129 county general fund.
- 130 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 131 after July 1, 2022, any person applying for a distinctive license 132 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 133 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 134 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 135 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 136 period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established 137 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license 138 139 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 140 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 141 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 142 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 143 collector.
