HOUSE BILL NO. 450

AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 41-37-27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THAT ALL AUTOPSIES CONDUCTED IN THIS STATE 3 INCLUDE AN INQUIRY TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE DEATH WAS A DIRECT RESULT OF A SEIZURE OR EPILEPSY; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE FINDINGS 5 IN AN AUTOPSY ARE CONSISTENT WITH KNOWN OR SUSPECTED SUDDEN UNEXPECTED DEATH IN EPILEPSY (SUDEP), THEN THE MEDICAL EXAMINER, 6 7 EXAMINING PHYSICIAN, OR CORONER SHALL CAUSE TO BE INDICATED ON THE DEATH CERTIFICATE THAT SUDEP IS THE CAUSE OR SUSPECTED CAUSE OF 8 9 DEATH, AND FORWARD A COPY OF THE DEATH CERTIFICATE TO THE NORTH 10 AMERICAN SUDEP REGISTRY WITHIN THIRTY DAYS; AND FOR RELATED 11 PURPOSES. 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section

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- 41-37-27, Mississippi Code of 1972: 14
- 15 41-37-27. (1) For the purposes of this section, the term
- "sudden unexpected death in epilepsy" means a death in a patient 16
- previously diagnosed with epilepsy that is not due to trauma, 17
- 18 drowning, status epilepticus, or other known causes, but for which
- there is often evidence of an associated seizure. A finding of 19
- 20 sudden unexpected death in epilepsy is definite when clinical
- 21 criteria are met and autopsy reveals no alternative cause of

- 22 death, such as stroke, myocardial infarction or drug intoxication,
- 23 although there may be evidence of a seizure.
- 24 (2) All autopsies conducted in this state shall include an
- 25 inquiry to determine whether the death was a direct result of a
- 26 seizure or epilepsy. If the findings in an autopsy of a medical
- 27 examiner, examining physician, or coroner are consistent with
- 28 known or suspected sudden unexpected death in epilepsy (SUDEP),
- 29 then the medical examiner, examining physician, or coroner shall:
- 30 (a) Cause to be indicated on the death certificate that
- 31 SUDEP is the cause or suspected cause of death; and
- 32 (b) Forward a copy of the death certificate to the
- 33 North American SUDEP Registry at the Langone Medical Center at New
- 34 York University within thirty (30) days.
- 35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 2022.
