- 11 Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of
- 12 radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or
- 13 highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used:
- 14 (a) By municipal law enforcement officers within a
- 15 municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more,
- 16 according to the latest federal decennial census, upon the public
- 17 streets of the municipality;

18	(b) By any college or university campus police force
19	within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand
20	(2,000) students are enrolled;
21	(c) By municipal law enforcement officers in any
22	municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand
