HOUSE BILL NO. 567

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-519, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972
2	TO DELETE THE POPULATION THRESHOLD FOR MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
3	OFFICERS TO USE RADAR SPEED DETECTION EQUIPMENT UPON THE PUBLIC
4	STREETS OF THE MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 63-3-519. It shall be unlawful for any person or peace
- 9 officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway
- 10 Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of
- 11 radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or
- 12 highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used:
- 13 (a) By municipal law enforcement officers * * * upon
- 14 the public streets of the municipality;
- 15 (b) By any college or university campus police force
- 16 within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand
- 17 (2,000) students are enrolled;
- 18 (c) By municipal law enforcement officers in any

19 municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand

- 20 (15,000) according to the latest federal census on federally
- 21 designated highways lying within the corporate limits.
- The Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol shall be immediately
- 23 notified by municipal law enforcement of any road blockages or
- 24 emergencies occurring on any federally designated limited-access
- 25 highways lying within the corporate limits.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2022.
