HOUSE BILL NO. 685

AN ACT TO REENACT SECTIONS 37-69-1 THROUGH 37-69-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH ARE THE ENERGY ACADEMY ACT THAT AUTHORIZES THE VICKSBURG-WARREN AND CLAIBORNE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO PARTNER WITH A NUCLEAR FACILITY, WARREN COUNTY AND 5 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENERGY HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMY; TO AMEND REENACTED SECTIONS 37-69-5 AND 37-69-7, 7 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO MAKE MINOR, NONSUBSTANTIVE WORDING CHANGES; TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-69-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 8 9 TO CODIFY AND EXTEND THE DATE OF THE REPEALER ON THE ENERGY ACADEMY ACT; TO AMEND SECTION 5, CHAPTER 482, LAWS OF 2019, TO 10 DELETE THE REPEALER ON THE ENERGY ACADEMY ACT FROM THE EFFECTIVE 11 12 DATE SECTION OF THE ENABLING LEGISLATION; AND FOR RELATED 13 PURPOSES.

- 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 37-69-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 15
- 16 reenacted as follows:
- 37-69-1. This chapter shall be known as "The Energy Academy 17
- 18 Act."
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 37-69-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 20 reenacted as follows:
- 21 37-69-3. **Intent.** The intent of the Legislature is to
- 22 provide an opportunity for motivated students to participate in a

- 23 curriculum that will prepare them for a career of employment in
- 24 the energy industry in their home state.
- 25 **SECTION 3.** Section 37-69-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 26 reenacted and amended as follows:
- 27 37-69-5. **Definitions**. For purposes of this chapter:
- 28 (a) "The Board of Trustees" means the Board of Trustees
- 29 of the Vicksburg-Warren School District.
- 30 (b) "The Board of Education" means the Claiborne County
- 31 Board of Education.
- 32 (c) "Nuclear Facility" means any nuclear generating
- 33 plant in the State of Mississippi.
- 34 (d) "Energy Academy" means an energy high school
- 35 created under this chapter.
- 36 (e) "Partnership Council" means the Energy High School
- 37 Academy Partnership Council.
- 38 (f) "MDA" means the Mississippi Development Authority.
- 39 **SECTION 4.** Section 37-69-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 40 reenacted and amended as follows:
- 41 37-69-7. (1) The Board of Trustees of the Vicksburg-Warren
- 42 School District and the Claiborne County Board of Education are
- 43 authorized to make application to the Mississippi Development
- 44 Authority for the approval of entering into a Memorandum of
- 45 Understanding with a nuclear facility and Warren County and the
- 46 State of Mississippi for the establishment of a partnership for
- 47 the operation of an Energy High School Academy. The purpose of

48	the	Energy	High	School	Academy	shall	be	to	provide	qualified

- 49 students attending school in Warren and/or Claiborne County in the
- 50 eighth through twelfth grade with career education, potential
- 51 student internships and continuing education for careers in the
- 52 energy industry.
- 53 (2) (a) The Energy High School Academy shall be under the
- 54 administrative direction of the Energy High School Academy
- 55 Partnership Council (Partnership Council) consisting of one (1)
- 56 member from each of the following entities:
- 57 (i) The Chief Executive Officer of an enterprise
- 58 engaged in the generation of nuclear energy located in Claiborne
- 59 County, or his designee, who shall serve for four (4) years;
- (ii) The superintendent of the Vicksburg-Warren
- 61 School District, who shall serve for four (4) years;
- 62 (iii) The superintendent of the Claiborne County
- 63 School District, who shall serve for four (4) years;
- 64 (iv) A designee of the Mississippi Development
- 65 Authority, appointed by the executive director of MDA, and * * *
- 66 who may be the executive director, who shall serve three (3)
- 67 years;
- 68 (v) A member of the Board of Trustees of the
- 69 Vicksburg-Warren School District, appointed by the Vicksburg Mayor
- 70 and Board of Alderman, who shall serve two (2) years;

71	(vi) A member of the Claiborne County Board of
72	Education, appointed by the Claiborne County Board of Supervisors,
73	who shall serve two (2) years;
74	(vii) A member of the Claiborne County Chamber of
75	Commerce, appointed by the chairman of the board of directors, who
76	may appoint himself or herself, and who shall serve one (1) year;
77	and
78	(viii) A member of the Vicksburg Chamber of
79	Commerce, appointed by the chairman of the board of directors, who
80	may appoint himself or herself, and who shall serve one (1) year.
81	(b) Members of the Partnership Council shall serve
82	staggered terms, as prescribed in paragraph (a) of this
83	subsection, commencing with the initial appointments made in 2019,
84	and shall thereafter, upon the expiration of the initial term, the
85	succeeding appointees shall serve a term of four (4) years.
86	Members of the council may be reappointed to the council by the
87	original appointing authority without limitation on the number of
88	terms served. In the event of a vacancy on the council, the
89	original appointing authority shall appoint a replacement to
90	complete the unexpired term of the member creating the vacancy.
91	(c) The Partnership Council shall meet on or before
92	August 1, 2019, and organize for business, elect officers and
93	adopt necessary regulations for the operation of the Energy High
94	School Academy. Meetings shall be held upon the call of the

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chairman.

96	(3) The Energy High School Academy Partnership Council shall
97	promulgate administrative rules and regulations to prescribe the
98	criteria to be used in the establishment of the Energy High School
99	Academy, which shall include student qualifications, application
100	requirements and curriculum components.

- 101 (4)(a) There is established in the State Treasury a fund 102 to be known as the "Energy High School Academy Fund." The purpose 103 of the fund is to provide necessary financial support to 104 Vicksburg-Warren/Claiborne County School Districts and the 105 Mississippi Development Authority for start-up costs and costs 106 associated with implementing and operating the Energy Academy 107 established under this section. The fund may consist of monies 108 obtained from grants from any public or private source. 109 Mississippi Development Authority shall administer the fund pursuant to appropriation by the Legislature, and may apply for 110 111 any grants from the federal government or private sources.
- 112 (b) The Mississippi Development Authority shall prepare
 113 a three-year budget proposal for the operation of the Energy
 114 Academy which shall include staff and liaison salary estimates,
 115 equipment and facility costs and job demand estimates. This
 116 budget shall be submitted to the Governor, the Legislative Budget
 117 Office and the Partnership Council and updated annually.
- SECTION 5. The following shall be codified as Section 37-69-9, Mississippi Code of 1972:

- 120 37-69-9. Sections 37-69-1 through 37-69-9 shall stand
- 121 repealed on July 1, 2025.
- SECTION 6. Section 5, Chapter 482, Laws of 2019, is amended
- 123 as follows:
- 124 Section 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 125 and after July 1, 2019 * * *.
- 126 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 127 and after July 1, 2022.
