HOUSE BILL NO. 691

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANY PERSON WHO POSSESSES A TABLET PRESS 2 MACHINE TO REGISTER THE MACHINE WITH THE MISSISSIPPI BUREAU OF NARCOTICS BY A CERTAIN DATE; TO PROVIDE THAT POSSESSION OF AN UNREGISTERED TABLET PRESS MACHINE SHALL BE UNLAWFUL; TO REQUIRE 5 ANY PERSON WHO PURCHASES A TABLET PRESS MACHINE TO KEEP CERTAIN 6 RECORDS; TO PROVIDE THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT MAY INSPECT SUCH RECORDS; 7 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 10 "Victoria Huggins Act."
- 11 SECTION 2. (1) (a) Any person who purchases, owns or
- 12 otherwise possesses a tablet press machine shall register the
- 13 machine with the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics. For purposes of
- 14 this section, the term "tablet press machine" means any device
- that transforms, molds, presses, compresses or otherwise shapes 15
- 16 powder materials into tablets or pills of sizes and/or shapes.
- 17 (b) From and after January 1, 2023, it shall be

- 18 unlawful for any person to possess a tablet press machine that is
- not registered with the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics. Any 19
- 20 person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty

- of a felony, fined no less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00),
- 22 imprisoned in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 23 Corrections for not less than two (2) years, nor more than five
- 24 (5) years, or both.
- 25 (2) (a) Any person who sells, transfers or otherwise
- 26 furnishes a tablet press machine shall maintain records of all
- 27 transactions, which shall include, at least:
- 28 (i) The name, address and age of the person from
- 29 whom the machine is purchased as obtained from the seller's
- 30 personal identification card;
- 31 (ii) The date and place of each acquisition of the
- 32 machine;
- 33 (iii) The weight, quantity or volume and a general
- 34 physical description of the type of machine purchased in a
- 35 purchase transaction;
- 36 (iv) The amount of consideration given in a
- 37 purchase transaction for the machine;
- 38 (v) The vehicle license tag number, state of issue
- 39 and the make and type of the vehicle used to deliver the machine
- 40 to the purchaser;
- 41 (vi) If a person other than the seller delivers
- 42 the machine to the purchaser, the name, address and age of the
- 43 person who delivers the machine;
- (vii) A signed statement from the person receiving
- 45 consideration in the purchase transaction stating that he is the

- A scanned copy or a photocopy of the 48
- personal identification card of the person receiving consideration 49
- 50 in the purchase transaction; or
- 51 (ix)If a person other than the seller delivers
- 52 the machine to the purchaser, a scanned copy or a photocopy of the
- personal identification card of the person delivering the metal 53
- 54 property to the purchaser; and
- 55 A photograph, videotape or similar likeness of (X)
- 56 the person receiving consideration or any person other than the
- 57 seller who delivers the machine to the purchaser in which the
- 58 person's facial features are clearly visible and in which the
- 59 machine the person is selling or delivering is clearly visible.
- 60 The records shall be maintained by the purchaser
- 61 for not less than two (2) years from the date of the purchase
- 62 transaction, and such records shall be made available to any law
- 63 enforcement officer.
- 64 The purchaser of the machine must hold the machine
- 65 separate and identifiable from other purchases for not less than
- 66 three (3) business days from the date of purchase. The purchaser
- 67 shall also photographically capture the machine in the same form,
- without change, in which the machine was acquired, and maintain 68
- 69 the photograph for a period of not less than two (2) years.
- time and date shall be digitally recorded on the photograph, and 70

- 71 the identity of the person taking the photograph shall be
- 72 recorded. The purchaser shall permit any law enforcement officer
- 73 to make an inspection of the machine during the holding period,
- 74 and of all photographs of the machine. Any photograph of the
- 75 machine taken and maintained pursuant to this subsection shall be
- 76 admissible in any civil or criminal proceeding.
- 77 (d) Any person who violates the provisions of this
- 78 section shall be guilty of a felony, fined no less than Five
- 79 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), imprisoned in the custody of the
- 80 Mississippi Department of Corrections for not less than two (2)
- 81 years, nor more than five (5) years, or both.
- 82 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 83 and after July 1, 2022.
