HOUSE BILL NO. 747

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State 10 Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of providing funding to Alcorn State University for the research program 11 described in Section 2 of this act for the fiscal year beginning 12 July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023..... \$ 2,500,000.00. 13 14 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by Section 1 of this act 15 shall be expended to defray the expenses of establishing a policy 16 and production research program at Alcorn State University on the 17 indoor production of medical marijuana, including the costs of construction of a laboratory, office space and greenhouse research 18 19 center, and for conducting educational, research, agribusiness,

SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue the warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

28 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 29 and after July 1, 2022.
