273 It shall be the duty of the municipal clerk of each (C) 274 municipality to deposit all the state assessments collected in the 275 municipal court in the municipality on a monthly basis with the 276 State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established by 277 the State Auditor. The municipal clerk shall make a monthly 278 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 279 municipal court in the municipality under this section, and shall 280 report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total 281 number of violations under each subsection for which state 282 assessments were collected in the municipal court in the 283 municipality during that month.

(11) It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all state assessments into the State General Fund or proper special fund in the State Treasury. The Department of Finance and Administration shall issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these funds.

(12) The State Auditor shall establish by regulation procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for
