HOUSE BILL NO. 811
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF U.S. HIGHWAY 80 IN
2 RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
3 CITY OF BRANDON, AS THE "DEPUTY TRAVIS O. BIDDLE MEMORIAL
4 HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF UNITED STATES HIGHWAY
5 80 IN RANKIN COUNTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF
6 PEARL, AS THE "RAY ROGERS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; AND FOR RELATED
7 PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** (1) The segment of U.S. Highway 80 located in
10 Rankin County, Mississippi, within the corporate limits of the
11 City of Brandon, from its intersection with Felicity Street
12 easterly to its intersection with North Street, is designated and
13 shall be known as the "Deputy Travis O. Biddle Memorial Highway.

14 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
15 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
16 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

17 **SECTION 2.** (1) The segment of United States Highway 80
18 located in Rankin County, Mississippi, within the corporate limits
19 of the City of Pearl, beginning at its intersection with Bierdeman
20 Road and extending easterly to its intersection with Pirates Cove,



21 is designated and shall be known as the "Ray Rogers Memorial
22 Highway".

23 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
24 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
25 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

26 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
27 and after July 1, 2022.
