HOUSE BILL NO. 862

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-1-52, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AND FACILITIES SHALL COMPLY 3 WITH THE FEDERAL HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY 4 ACT (HIPAA) IN CHARGING FEES FOR PROVIDING AN INDIVIDUAL'S 5 PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION TO THE INDIVIDUAL; TO PROVIDE THAT 6 HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AND FACILITIES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE FEE 7 SCHEDULE IN THIS SECTION IN CHARGING FEES FOR PHOTOCOPYING AND PROVIDING AN INDIVIDUAL'S PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION TO A THIRD 8 9 PARTY; TO SET THE MAXIMUM AMOUNTS OF FEES THAT HEALTH CARE 10 PROVIDERS AND FACILITIES MAY CHARGE FOR SENDING AN INDIVIDUAL'S 11 PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION ELECTRONICALLY TO OR REPRODUCING THE 12 INFORMATION IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT FOR A THIRD PARTY; AND FOR 13 RELATED PURPOSES.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 15 SECTION 1. Section 11-1-52, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 16 amended as follows:

17 11-1-52. (1) In charging fees for providing to an

- 18 individual his or her protected health information as requested by
- 19 the individual or his or her personal representative, a covered
- 20 entity shall comply with the federal Health Insurance Portability
- 21 and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), as amended, and its
- 22 implementing regulations.

23 (2) In charging fees for providing an individual's protected 24 health information to a third party at the direction of the 25 individual or his or her personal representative, or for providing 26 an individual's protected health information to a third party that 27 has been authorized to access the individual's protected health 28 information by a HIPAA authorization form signed by the individual 29 or his or her authorized representative: 30 * * * A medical provider or hospital or nursing (a) 31 home or other medical facility shall charge no more than the following amounts to * * * individuals or their personal 32 33 representatives for photocopying any * * * protected health 34 information of the individual: 35 (i) Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for pages one (1) 36 through twenty (20); One Dollar (\$1.00) per page for the next eighty (80) pages; Fifty Cents (50¢) per page for all pages 37 38 thereafter. 39 Ten percent (10%) of the total charge may be (ii) added for postage and handling. 40 41 (iii) Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) may be recovered by 42 the medical provider or hospital or nursing home or other medical facility for retrieving medical records in archives at a location 43 44 off the premises where the facility/office is located. 45 (b) A medical provider or hospital or nursing home or other medical facility shall charge no more than the following 46 47 amounts to individuals or their personal representatives for

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48 providing electronic records of any protected health information 49 of the individual to third parties as described in subsection (2) 50 of this section: 51 (i) If the individual's protected health 52 information is maintained electronically by or on behalf of the 53 provider or facility and the individual or his or her 54 representative requests the information to be sent electronically 55 to or reproduced in electronic format for a third party, Thirty 56 Dollars (\$30.00) regardless of the number of pages, plus the 57 actual cost of any supplies needed to reproduce the information in 58 portable electronic media (e.g. a CD or USB drive), and the actual 59 cost of any postage if the portable electronic media is mailed. 60 (ii) If the individual's protected health 61 information is not maintained electronically by or on behalf of 62 the provider or facility and the individual or his or her 63 representative requests the information to be sent electronically 64 to or reproduced in electronic format for a third party, the 65 actual cost of the provider or facility for time and labor in 66 converting the information to electronic format but not exceeding Twenty-five Cents (25¢) per page, plus the actual cost of any 67 68 supplies needed to reproduce the information in portable electronic media (e.g. a CD or USB drive), and the actual cost of 69 70 any postage if the portable electronic media is mailed.

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74 (***<u>4</u>) Any medical provider, hospital, nursing home or 75 other medical facility shall charge no more than Twenty-five 76 Dollars (\$25.00) for executing a medical record affidavit, when 77 the affidavit is requested by the patient or the patient's 78 representative.

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80 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 2022.
