- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-60-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows:

- 12 as a home inspector, or holds himself out as a home inspector,
- 13 without being licensed under this chapter, shall, in addition to
- any other penalty provided by law, be liable for an administrative 14
- fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for a first 15
- 16 offense and not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for a
- 17 second or subsequent offense as determined by the commission.

- investigate any and all unlicensed activity. 19
