## HOUSE BILL NO. 883

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-29-65, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE FOR THE REVISED COMPOSITION OF THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES FOR THE NORTHEAST MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT AND THE 3 COAHOMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO REPRESENT THE BOARDS' MAKE 4 UP AS IT EXISTED BEFORE JULY 1, 2019; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-29-65, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 37-29-65. (1) Except as provided in this section and in 10 Sections 37-29-409, 37-29-457 and 37-29-505, there shall be five (5) trustees from each county of the community college district 11 12 which originally entered into and gave financial aid in establishing the community college. On June 30, 1992, the offices 13 14 of the six (6) trustees from each of the original counties in the Northwest Community College District shall stand vacated. The 15 16 board of supervisors of those respective counties shall appoint two (2) members on July 1, 1992, to serve full terms of office as 17 provided in this section. The board of supervisors of those 18 19 respective counties shall appoint one (1) member who is a

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20 qualified elector from each supervisors district to serve as a 21 member, either of which may be the county superintendent of 22 education if he or she resides in a respective supervisors 23 district. Counties which subsequent to the establishment of the 24 community college joined the district shall have only one (1) 25 trustee. However, the board of trustees so constituted, by appropriate resolution, may enlarge its number to six (6) trustees 26 from each county. The board of trustees shall also be authorized 27 28 within its discretion to reduce its number to two (2) trustees at 29 large from each county. In any case in which there is an equal 30 number of trustees the board of trustees may appoint another person to membership. 31

The county superintendent, if appointed by the county 32 (2)board of supervisors, may, in his discretion, choose not to serve 33 as a member of such board of trustees. Such decision not to serve 34 35 shall be in writing and entered on the minutes of the board of 36 trustees of the community college district. The county board of 37 supervisors of any county whose county superintendent of education 38 appointed under the authority of this section, declines the 39 appointment or resigns, pursuant to this subsection (2), shall 40 fill the vacancy caused by such resignation by appointing a member who is a qualified elector of the county at large in accordance 41 with subsection (  $\star \star \star 7$ ) of this section. No county 42 superintendent whose school district is located within the East 43

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44 Mississippi Community College District shall serve on the board of 45 trustees for that community college district.

From and after March 24, 1990, the Board of Trustees of 46 (3) the East Mississippi Community College District shall consist of 47 48 twelve (12) members. The appointing authorities shall appoint a 49 new board of trustees as follows: Clay County shall be entitled to two (2) members, Kemper County shall be entitled to two (2) 50 51 members, Lauderdale County shall be entitled to two (2) members, Lowndes County shall be entitled to two (2) members, Noxubee 52 County shall be entitled to two (2) members and Oktibbeha County 53 54 shall be entitled to two (2) members. No member of the Board of 55 Trustees of the East Mississippi Community College District shall 56 have served on such board prior to March 24, 1990.

57 From and after July 1, 2022, the Board of Trustees of (4) 58 the Coahoma Community College District shall consist of \* \* \* 59 fourteen (14) members. The appointing authorities shall appoint 60 the new board of trustees as follows: Coahoma County shall be entitled to \* \* \* six (6) members appointed in the manner provided 61 62 herein, Tunica County shall be entitled to \* \* \* two (2) members, Quitman County shall be entitled to \* \* \* two (2) members, Bolivar 63 64 County shall be entitled to \* \* \* two (2) members, and 65 Tallahatchie County shall be entitled to \* \* \* two (2) members, 66 one (1) of whom may be a superintendent of education within the county. One (1) member from each county that comprises the 67 Coahoma Community College District shall be the county 68

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69 <u>superintendent of education.</u> Persons who are currently serving as 70 members of the Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Delta 71 Community College District or Northwest Community College District 72 shall <u>not</u> be eligible for appointment to the board.

73 (5) The terms of office shall be five (5) years; however, 74 upon the first selection of trustees in each county, one (1) shall 75 be elected for a term of five (5) years, one (1) for a term of 76 four (4) years, one (1) for a term of three (3) years, one (1) for 77 a term of two (2) years, and one (1) for a term of one (1) year, 78 so as to prevent the retirement of more than one (1) member of any 79 one (1) county in any one (1) year. Where the board chooses or is 80 required by statute to reduce its number, the board shall specify 81 the expiration dates of such terms of office in order to prevent 82 the retirement of more than one (1) member of any one (1) county 83 in any one (1) year.

(6) (a) From and after July 1, 2022, the Board of Trustees 84 85 of the Northeast Mississippi Community College District shall consist of fifteen (15) members from the Prentiss, Alcorn, Tippah, 86 87 Tishomingo and Union Counties. The appointing authorities, being the respective county boards of supervisors, shall appoint the 88 89 trustees as follows: 90 (i) Prentiss County shall be entitled to six (6) 91 members; 92 (ii) Alcorn County shall be entitled to two (2) 93 members;

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94 (iii) Tippah County shall be entitled to two (2) 95 members; 96 Tishomingo County shall be entitled to two (iv) 97 (2) members; 98 Union County shall be entitled to two (2) (V) 99 members; and (vi) One (1) member shall be elected at-large by 100 101 the members of the board, which shall be made from each of the 102 counties having only two (2) members on a rotational basis at the 103 expiration of each term. 104 (b) Of the members so appointed under paragraph (a) of 105 this subsection, one (1) of the trustees from each county may be 106 the county superintendent of education, provided that the 107 president of the Northeast Community College submits a letter of 108 recommendation to the boards of supervisors of each county 109 requesting the appointment of the county superintendent of 110 education. However, each county board of supervisors retains the sole discretion to appoint any qualified elector residing in the 111 112 county to the board of trustees for the community college district 113 despite the receipt of such recommendation. If the board of 114 supervisors accepts the recommendation of the president of 115 Northeast Community College for the appointment of the county 116 superintendent of education for a term, the recommendation shall 117 only be valid for the term of the superintendent then appointed by 118 the board of supervisors, and must be renewed upon the expiration

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of the term of the appointed superintendent with the submission of a new recommendation by the president for continued representation on the board by the county superintendent of education.

122 The terms of office of each trustee shall be five (C) 123 (5) years. The members of the board of trustees serving on July 124 1, 2021, shall continue to serve until their terms expire. Where 125 the board chooses or is required by statute to reduce or increase 126 its number, the board shall specify the expiration dates of such 127 terms of office in order to prevent the retirement of more than 128 one (1) member of any one (1) county in any one (1) year.

129 ( \* \* \*7) The board of supervisors shall elect the requisite 130 number of discreet persons of good moral character, sufficient 131 education and experience, and of proven interest in public 132 education, who are qualified electors of the county, as trustees of the community college; and annually thereafter the board of 133 134 supervisors in like manner shall fill vacancies. All trustees so 135 appointed shall be listed in the minutes of the board of supervisors and their appointment shall be certified by the 136 137 chancery clerk to the president of the community college.

138 (\* \* \*<u>8</u>) Each community college trustee may be paid, out of 139 community college funds, a per diem as authorized in Section 140 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, per meeting of said board and, 141 in addition thereto, the mileage authorized under Section 25-3-41, 142 Mississippi Code of 1972, per mile in coming to and returning from 143 said meeting, calculated upon the customary and normally traveled

Such allowance of per diem and mileage shall 146 not, however, be allowed for more than fifteen (15) meetings for 147 any one (1) fiscal year and shall only be paid for meetings 148 actually attended by such trustees.

149 (\*\*\*<u>9</u>) The provisions of this section, other than those 150 provisions pertaining to per diem compensation and travel 151 allowances for community college trustees, shall not apply to any 152 existing publicly operated community college, lying in and 153 operated by a county bordering on the Mississippi River, and the 154 community college trustees of such community college shall be 155 appointed and confirmed as heretofore.

156 (\* \* \*10) No county superintendent of education, by virtue 157 of his or her office, shall be automatically placed on the board of trustees for any community college district to which this 158 159 section applies. The number of trustees from each county shall be 160 reduced by one (1) member if such member is superintendent of education. However, if the county board of supervisors, in making 161 162 an appointment to the community college district board of 163 trustees, chooses to appoint the county superintendent of 164 education at the expiration of the term of the at large member, 165 the superintendent may serve, unless otherwise disqualified.

166 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 167 and after July 1, 2022.
