## HOUSE BILL NO. 896

AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 43-13-117.6, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID SHALL REIMBURSE FOR 3 OUTPATIENT HOSPITAL SERVICES PROVIDED TO ELIGIBLE MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES UNDER THE AGE OF 21 BY BORDER CITY 5 UNIVERSITY-AFFILIATED PEDIATRIC TEACHING HOSPITALS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE DIVISION SHALL SEEK ANY NECESSARY WAIVERS AND MAKE ANY 6 7 REQUIRED AMENDMENTS TO ITS STATE PLAN; TO PROVIDE THAT FOR CLAIMS WITH DATES OF SERVICE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2022, SUCH SERVICES 8 9 SHALL BE REIMBURSED BASED ON REASONABLE COSTS WITH INTERIM PAYMENTS AND A YEAR-END COST SETTLEMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 43-13-117.6, Mississippi Code of 1972: 13 43-13-117.6. (1) The Division of Medicaid shall reimburse 14 15 for outpatient hospital services provided to eligible Medicaid beneficiaries under the age of twenty-one (21) by border city 16 17 university-affiliated pediatric teaching hospitals. The division shall seek any necessary waivers, make any required amendments to 18 its state plan or revise any contracts authorized under Section 19 20 43-13-117(H) as necessary to provide the services authorized under this section. - 23 Medicaid beneficiaries under the age of twenty-one (21) at border
- 24 city university-affiliated pediatric teaching hospitals shall be
- 25 reimbursed based on reasonable costs with interim payments and a
- 26 year-end cost settlement. The division shall use cost data in
- 27 accordance with federal law and federal regulations consistent
- 28 with the method used for identifying cost for private hospital
- 29 access payments. The division shall use the lesser of the
- 30 reasonable costs or customary charges to establish cost
- 31 settlements. The cost settlements shall be calculated using the
- 32 methods and standards used by the Medicare Program.
- 33 (2) As used in this section, the term "border city
- 34 university-affiliated pediatric teaching hospital" means an
- 35 out-of-state hospital located within a county contiguous to the
- 36 state line that submits to the division a copy of a current and
- 37 effective affiliation agreement with an accredited university, and
- 38 documentation establishing that the hospital is
- 39 university-affiliated, is licensed and designated as a pediatric
- 40 hospital or pediatric primary hospital within its home state,
- 41 maintains at least five (5) different intern pediatric specialty
- 42 training programs, and maintains at least one hundred (100)
- 43 operated beds dedicated exclusively for the treatment of patients
- 44 under the age of twenty-one (21).
- 45 (3) It is the intent of the Legislature that the cost of
- 46 providing services to Medicaid beneficiaries under the age of
- 47 twenty-one (21) who are treated by a border city

- 48 university-affiliated pediatric teaching hospital shall not exceed
- 49 the cost of providing the same services to individuals in
- 50 hospitals in the state.
- 51 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 52 and after July 1, 2022.
