## HOUSE BILL NO. 897

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-9-39, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REDUCE TO 50 YEARS OF AGE THE MINIMUM AGE OF HOSPITAL INPATIENTS 3 WHO MUST BE OFFERED IMMUNIZATIONS AGAINST INFLUENZA VIRUS BEFORE THEIR DISCHARGE FROM THE HOSPITAL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 41-9-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- 7 amended as follows:
- 41-9-39. (1) Each year from October 1 through March 1 and 8
- 9 in accordance with the latest recommendations of the Advisory
- 10 Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease
- Control and Prevention, each hospital shall offer, prior to 11
- 12 discharge, immunizations against influenza virus to all
- inpatients \* \* \* fifty (50) years of age and older unless 13
- 14 contraindicated and contingent upon the availability of the
- 15 vaccine.
- Any hospital, or employee thereof, shall be immune from 16
- 17 civil liability for any personal injury as a result of complying
- or not complying with the requirements of subsection (1) if the 18

- 19 hospital or employee's action or failure to act do not amount to
- 20 willful or wanton misconduct or gross negligence.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2022.
