HOUSE BILL NO. 949

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.93, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO REVISE THE DISTRIBUTION OF FEES COLLECTED FROM THE 3 ISSUANCE OF BREAST CANCER AWARENESS DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 4 LICENSE TAGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.93, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 27-19-56.93. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a 9 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws 10 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes 11 12 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 13 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 14 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a 15 special breast cancer awareness license tag for each motor vehicle 16 17 registered in his name. The distinctive license tags so issued 18 shall be of such color and design as the Department of Revenue, with the advice of the \* \* \* Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer 19 H. B. Foundation, may prescribe, and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

23 Application for the distinctive license tags authorized (2)24 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 25 prescribed by the Department of Revenue. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 26 27 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 28 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue on a monthly basis 29 as prescribed by the department. The portion of the additional 30 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 31 county general fund.

32 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (3) after July 1, 2004, any person applying for a distinctive license 33 34 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 35 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 36 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 37 38 period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established 39 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 40 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 41 42 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 43 license taq. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive

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44 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 45 collector.

The Department of Revenue shall deposit all fees into 46 (4) 47 the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each 48 month, the Department of Revenue shall certify to the State 49 Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this 50 The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as 51 section. 52 follows:

(a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be disbursed to the \* \* Mississippi <u>Breast and</u>
Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program.

57 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 58 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 59 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant 60 to Section 7-9-70.

61 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
62 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
63 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
64 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
65 reconstruction of highways.

66 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 67 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall

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68 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section 69 27-19-44.2.

70 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 71 72 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 73 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 74 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 75 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 76 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 77 tag.

78 In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) 79 taq issued under this section, the owner may make application and 80 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 81 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 82 83 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 84 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 85 86 distributed proportionately in the same manner as funds from the 87 sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this 88 section.

89 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 90 and after July 1, 2022.

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
