HOUSE BILL NO. 972

AN ACT TO CREATE A PILOT PROGRAM FOR BOTTOM LAND LEASING FOR OYSTER PRODUCTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES TO LEASE CERTAIN AREAS OF BOTTOM LAND FOR OYSTER PRODUCTION TO OYSTER AND/OR SEAFOOD PROCESSORS WHO ONLY OPERATE IN THE WATERS 5 ADJACENT TO HANCOCK COUNTY; TO PROVIDE THE PRICE AND LENGTH OF THE LEASE; TO PROVIDE THAT FUNDS DERIVED FROM THE LEASE SHALL BE 7 DEPOSITED INTO SEAFOOD FUND TO FURTHER OYSTER PRODUCTION IN THIS 8 STATE, WHICH INCLUDES PLANTINGS OF OYSTERS AND CULTCH MATERIALS; 9 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Marine Resources,
- 12 hereinafter called the "department," shall conduct a pilot program
- for bottom land leasing for oyster production. The department 13
- 14 shall lease to oyster and/or seafood processors who only operate
- in the waters adjacent to Hancock County the following areas of 15
- 16 bottom lands for oyster production:
- 17 (a) Area 1: The tonging area in Hancock County from
- 18 the Bay St. Louis Railroad Bridge to Long Point, which is five
- 19 hundred (500) feet offshore to one (1) mile offshore.
- 20 (b) Area 2: Telegraph Reef.

- 22 the department must make an affirmative finding that the lessee is
- 23 an oyster and/or seafood processor who only operates in the waters
- 24 adjacent to Hancock County.
- 25 (b) The lease shall be for a term of five (5) years,
- 26 and the lessee shall have the first right to renew the lease for
- 27 an additional five (5) years. Before such renewal, the department
- 28 may adjust the acreage and price of the lease to reflect the total
- 29 number of acres of oyster production.
- 30 (c) Each lease shall set a price at Two Dollars (\$2.00)
- 31 per acre for at least the first five (5) years of the lease.
- 32 (d) All funds derived from leasing shall be paid to the
- 33 department for deposit into the Seafood Fund under Section
- 34 49-15-17, for use by the department to further oyster production
- 35 in this state, which includes plantings of oysters and cultch
- 36 materials.
- 37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after its passage.
