HOUSE BILL NO. 996

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE SCENIC RIVERS 2 DEVELOPMENT ALLIANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDING FOR NECESSARY WATER, SEWER, TOURISM AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS 4 IN PIKE, AMITE, WALTHALL, WILKINSON AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES TO 5 FURTHER UPGRADE THE RECREATIONAL AND TOURISM RELATED ASSETS THAT 6 PROMOTE ECONOMIC BENEFITS TO THE RESIDENTS OF SOUTHWEST 7 MISSISSIPPI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus 10 11 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Scenic Rivers Development Alliance for the purpose of providing 12 13 funding for necessary water, sewer, tourism and economic 14 development projects to further upgrade the recreational and tourism related assets that promote economic benefits to the 15 16 residents of Southwest Mississippi, as provided in Section 2 of this act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending 17 June 30, 2023.....\$ 11,010,000.00. 18 SECTION 2. The money appropriated in Section 1 of this act 19 20 shall be expended by the alliance for the following projects:

21	(a)	Pike	County:
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- (i) \$1,500,000.00 for Quail Hollow Golf Course
- 23 water improvements; and
- 24 (ii) \$1,900,000.00 for Bogue Chitto Water Park
- 25 water and sewer improvements.
- 26 (b) Amite County:
- (i) \$900,000.00 for Ethel Vance Park water and
- 28 sewer improvements; and
- 29 (ii) \$240,000.00 for Liberty Ballfield Complex
- 30 infrastructure repair and improvements.
- 31 (c) Walthall County:
- 32 (i) \$60,000.00 for Walkers Bridge Water Park
- 33 infrastructure repair and improvements;
- 34 (ii) \$165,000.00 for County Range infrastructure
- 35 repair and improvements; and
- 36 (iii) \$225,000.00 for Lake Walthall bank
- 37 restoration and infrastructure improvements.
- 38 (d) Wilkinson County:
- 39 (i) \$420,000.00 for Wilkinson County Park
- 40 infrastructure improvements; and
- 41 (ii) \$2,900,000.00 for Lake Mary Road
- 42 improvements.
- 43 (e) Franklin County: \$2,700,000.00 for recreation sites
- 44 associated with Okhissa Lake project.

- 45 **SECTION 3.** (1) As used in this section and Section 4 of 46 this act, the term "alliance" means the Department of Scenic 47 Rivers Development Alliance.
- 48 (2) The alliance shall not disburse any funds appropriated
- 49 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an
- 50 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in
- 51 the alliance's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures
- 52 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as
- 53 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 54 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules,
- 55 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or
- 56 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of
- 57 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not
- 58 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in
- 59 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds,
- 60 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal
- 61 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In
- 62 addition, the alliance shall ensure that all funds appropriated
- 63 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit
- 64 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the
- 65 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal
- 66 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient
- 67 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit
- 68 requirements.

- 69 (1) As a condition of receiving and expending 70 the funds appropriated to the alliance under this act, the 71 alliance shall certify to the Department of Finance and 72 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to 73 the alliance under this act complies with the guidelines, 74 quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be 75 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the 76 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State
- 78 If the Office of Inspector General of the United States (2) 79 Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 80 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 81 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 82 ARPA (a) determines that the alliance or recipient has expended or 83 otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the alliance under 84 this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the 85 quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 86 87 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 88 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State 89 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any 90 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined were expended or otherwise used improperly by the alliance or 91 92 recipient, then the alliance or recipient that expended or

otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the

Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.

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96	SECTION 5. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
97	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State
98	Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants
99	issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer
100	shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the
101	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

and after July 1, 2022.

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
