HOUSE BILL NO. 1006

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD TO ESTABLISH THE COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGE NURSING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING PROGRAM, WHICH WILL PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO THE PUBLIC COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES TO EXPAND AND IMPROVE THE OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE EXISTING NURSING DEGREE PROGRAMS THAT ARE OFFERED AT THE COLLEGES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Community College Board 10 shall establish the Community and Junior College Nursing 11 Supplemental Funding Program, which will provide additional funding to the public community and junior colleges to expand and 12 13 improve the operation and administration of the existing nursing 14 degree programs that are offered at the colleges. The board shall 15 adopt such rules and regulations as necessary for the 16 administration of the program.

17 (2) Under the supplemental funding program, the board shall 18 receive applications from the colleges requesting additional 19 funding for their nursing programs, describing in detail how the 20 funds will be used by the colleges, how the receipt of the funds

The board shall develop a 23 system to use for ranking the applications received, so that the additional funding will be provided to those colleges that have 24 25 the greatest need for the funds for the operation of their nursing 26 programs, and those colleges that can provide the greatest benefit 27 to nursing education and the nursing profession in Mississippi by 28 expansion or improvement of their nursing programs.

(3) An application for additional funding under the program
shall be submitted at such time, be in such form, and contain such
information as the board prescribes.

32 (4) The board shall operate the supplemental funding program 33 and provide additional funding to colleges under the program from 34 any funds appropriated to the board by the Legislature for that 35 purpose.

36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after July 1, 2022.
