HOUSE BILL NO. 1039

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-115-85, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
 TO PROVIDE THAT TEN PERCENT OF THE LOTTERY PROCEEDS FUND SHALL BE
 USED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S OFFICE OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT
 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS; AND FOR RELATED
 PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 27-115-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 27-115-85. Until June 30, 2028, net proceeds generated by
- 10 the Alyce G. Clarke Mississippi Lottery Law, created pursuant to
- 11 this chapter and deposited into the Lottery Proceeds Fund under
- 12 Section 27-115-51(2), except as otherwise provided in this
- 13 section, shall be paid into the State Highway Fund by warrant
- 14 issued by the State Fiscal Officer upon requisition of the State
- 15 Transportation Commission as needed to provide funds to repair,
- 16 renovate and maintain highways and bridges of the state; however,
- 17 funds paid into the State Highway Fund under this section shall be
- 18 first used for matching federal funds authorized to the state
- 19 pursuant to any federal highway infrastructure program implemented

- 20 after September 1, 2018. However, ten percent (10%) of all such
- 21 monies deposited into the Lottery Proceeds Fund in a fiscal year
- 22 shall be used by the Department of Education's Office of School
- 23 Improvement for the purposes of funding school improvements, and
- 24 all such monies deposited into the Lottery Proceeds Fund over
- 25 Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) in a fiscal year shall be
- 26 transferred into the Education Enhancement Fund for the purposes
- 27 of funding the Early Childhood Learning Collaborative, the
- 28 Classroom Supply Fund and/or other educational purposes. From and
- 29 after July 1, 2028, the net proceeds shall be deposited into the
- 30 Lottery Proceeds Fund and shall be transferred to the State
- 31 General Fund, except for the ten percent (10%) which shall
- 32 continue to be used to fund school improvements, and for the
- 33 amounts over Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) which shall
- 34 continue to be deposited in the Education Enhancement Fund as
- 35 provided above.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 2022.
