## HOUSE BILL NO. 1118

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-41-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF "PUBLIC BODY" IN THE PROVISIONS OF LAW REGULATING OPEN MEETINGS BY ADDING "SUBCOMMITTEE" TO THE DEFINITION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-41-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 25-41-3. For purposes of this chapter, the following words
- 9 shall have the meaning ascribed herein, to wit:
- 10 (a) "Public body" means any executive or administrative
- 11 board, commission, authority, council, department, agency, bureau
- 12 or any other policymaking entity, \* \* \* committee or subcommittee
- 13 thereof, of the State of Mississippi, or any political subdivision
- 14 or municipal corporation of the state, whether the entity be
- 15 created by statute or executive order, which is supported wholly
- 16 or in part by public funds or expends public funds, and any
- 17 standing, interim or special committee of the Mississippi
- 18 Legislature. The term "public body" includes the governing board
- 19 of a charter school authorized by the Mississippi Charter School

- 20 Authorizer Board and the board of trustees of a community hospital
- 21 as defined in Section 41-13-10. The term "public body" includes
- 22 the Mississippi Lottery Corporation. There shall be exempted from
- 23 the provisions of this chapter:
- 24 (i) The judiciary, including all jury
- 25 deliberations;
- 26 (ii) Law enforcement officials;
- 27 (iii) The military;
- 28 (iv) The State Probation and Parole Board;
- 29 (v) The Workers' Compensation Commission;
- 30 (vi) Legislative \* \* \* conference committees;
- 31 (vii) The arbitration council established in
- 32 Section 69-3-19;
- 33 (viii) License revocation, suspension and
- 34 disciplinary proceedings held by the Mississippi State Board of
- 35 Dental Examiners; and
- 36 (ix) Hearings and meetings of the Board of Tax
- 37 Appeals and of the hearing officers and the board of review of the
- 38 Department of Revenue as provided in Section 27-77-15.
- 39 (b) "Meeting" means an assemblage of members of a
- 40 public body at which official acts may be taken upon a matter over
- 41 which the public body has supervision, control, jurisdiction or
- 42 advisory power, including an assemblage through the use of video
- 43 or teleconference devices that conforms to Section 25-41-5.

44 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

45 and after July 1, 2022.
