HOUSE BILL NO. 1132

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ADD 350 HIGH STREET, 401 NORTH LAMAR STREET, AND 455 NORTH LAMAR STREET, TO THE LIST OF STATE PROPERTIES LOCATED IN THE CITY OF JACKSON THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION IS 5 REQUIRED TO EXERCISE GENERAL SUPERVISION AND CARE OVER AND KEEP IN 6 GOOD CONDITION; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO SOLICIT AND APPROVE 7 OR DISAPPROVE ANY LEASE, USE OR RENTAL AGREEMENT FOR A CHARGE OR OTHER CONSIDERATION FOR CERTAIN SPACE NOT EXCEEDING THREE THOUSAND 8 9 SQUARE FEET IN ANY INDIVIDUAL BUILDING, WITH A PRIVATE ENTRY WHO WILL PROVIDE FOOD AND/OR CATERING SERVICES FOR STATE EMPLOYEES, 10 11 VISITORS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC; TO REQUIRE THAT THE DEPARTMENT 12 SELECT THE ENTITY FOR SUCH LEASE, CONTRACT, OR RENTAL AGREEMENT 13 USING A COMPETITIVE PROCESS THAT IS PUBLICLY ADVERTISED; TO REOUIRE THAT THE DEPARTMENT DEMONSTRATE THAT ANY SUCH AGREEMENT 14 ENTERED INTO WILL NEITHER RESULT IN A NET COST TO THE STATE, NOR 15 IMPAIR OR IMPEDE THE FUNCTION OF STATE AGENCIES AT SUCH LOCATION; 16 17 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- SECTION 1. Section 29-5-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 19

- 21 29-5-2. The duties of the Department of Finance and

- 23 (a) (i) To exercise general supervision and care over

- 30 Mississippi Museum Complex, the Gulf, Mobile and Ohio Train Depot
- 31 (GM&O Depot), the Old State Capitol Building, the Governor's
- 32 Mansion, the Heber Ladner Building, the Robert E. Lee Office
- 33 Building, the Robert E. Lee Parking Garage, the former Naval
- 34 Reserve Center, 515 East Amite Street, 620 North Street, 660 North
- 35 Street, 700 North State Street, 350 High Street, 401 North Lamar
- 36 Street, 455 North Lamar Street, the State Records Center, the
- 37 Robert G. Clark, Jr. Building, the Mississippi State Fairgrounds
- 38 Complex, * * * the former Central High Building, as well as all
- 39 state-owned or leased buildings situated on seat of government

- 41 (ii) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 42 and keep in good condition the Dr. Eldon Langston Bolton Building
- 43 located in Biloxi, Mississippi.
- 44 (iii) To exercise general supervision and care
- 45 over and keep in good condition the State Service Center, located
- 46 at the intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and John Merl Tatum
- 47 Industrial Drive in Hattiesburg, Mississippi.
- 48 (iv) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 49 and keep in good condition any property purchased, constructed or
- 50 otherwise acquired by the State of Mississippi for conducting

52 by any other state entity, but which is reasonably assumed the department would be responsible for such, as approved by the 53 Public Procurement Review Board, including, but not limited to: 54 55 The National Aeronautics and Space 56 Administration (NASA) Shared Services Center and Lockheed Martin 57 Building at Stennis Space Center; 58 2. The Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame; 59 The Mississippi Crafts Center; 3. The Mississippi Children's Museum; and 60 4. 61 5. The Mississippi Arts and Entertainment 62 Center. 63 To assign suitable office space for the various (b) state departments, officers and employees who are provided with an 64 65 office in any of the buildings under the jurisdiction or control 66 of the Department of Finance and Administration. However, the 67 assignment of space in the New Capitol Building shall be 68 designated by duly passed resolution of the combined Senate Rules 69 Committee and the House Management Committee, meeting as a joint 70 committee, approved by the Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the 71 House of Representatives. A majority vote of the members of the 72 Senate Rules Committee and a majority vote of the members of the 73 House Management Committee shall be required on all actions taken,

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- 78 To approve or disapprove with the concurrence of 79 the Public Procurement Review Board, any lease or rental 80 agreements by any state agency or department, including any state 81 agency financed entirely by federal and special funds, for space outside the buildings under the jurisdiction of the Department of 82 Finance and Administration, including space necessary for parking 83 to be used by state employees who work in the Woolfolk Building, 84 the Carroll Gartin Justice Building or the Walter Sillers Office 85 86 Building. In no event shall any employee, officer, department, 87 federally funded agency or bureau of the state be authorized to 88 enter into a lease or rental agreement without prior approval of the Department of Finance and Administration and the Public 89 90 Procurement Review Board.
- The Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to use architects, engineers, building inspectors and other personnel for the purpose of making inspections as may be deemed necessary in carrying out its duties and maintaining the facilities.
- This section is not intended to apply to locations for which
 the Department of Finance and Administration has decided to
 solicit proposals in accordance with subsection (e) of this
 section.
- 99 (d) To acquire by lease, lease-purchase agreement, or 100 otherwise, as provided in Section 27-104-107, and to assign
