HOUSE BILL NO. 1164 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 57-10-601, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 WHICH DESIGNATES THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AS THE 3 AGENCY TO IMPLEMENT A STATE PROGRAM AND PARTICIPATE IN THE FEDERAL STATE SMALL BUSINESS CREDIT INITIATIVE ACT OF 2010, TO AUTHORIZE 4 THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO FORM A PRIVATE NONPROFIT 5 6 ENTITY THAT IS EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAXATION, THE PURPOSE OF 7 WHICH IS TO PROMOTE, AID AND ENCOURAGE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THIS STATE OR A LOCALITY OR REGION OF THIS STATE, AND FOR OTHER 8 9 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 SECTION 1. Section 57-10-601, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

19 (c) "MDA" means the Mississippi Development Authority.

(2) The MDA is designated as the agency to implement a state
program and participate in the State Small Business Credit
Initiative established under the act.

(3) The MDA is authorized and empowered to take any action necessary to establish and implement a state program that meets all the requirements of the act.

26 (4) The MDA is authorized and empowered to administer funds27 transferred to the state under the act.

(5) In addition to all other plenary power and authority, the MDA is authorized and empowered to form a private nonprofit entity that is exempt from federal income taxation, the purpose of which is to promote, aid and encourage economic development in this state or a locality or region of this state, and for other economic development purposes.
(***6) The Executive Director of MDA * * * shall

35 promulgate and put into effect all reasonable rules and 36 regulations that he <u>or she</u> may deem necessary to carry out the 37 provisions of this section and comply with the act.

38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.
