HOUSE BILL NO. 1335

AN ACT TO EXEMPT ALL PRIVATELY OWNED, RECREATIONAL BOATS
MANUFACTURED BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1965, THAT ARE REGISTERED WITH THE
DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS FROM THE THREE YEAR
REGISTRATION RENEWAL REQUIREMENT; TO REQUIRE THAT THE BOAT
REGISTRATION NUMBER BE PLACED ON THE INSIDE OF THE BOAT; TO
REQUIRE THAT THE ORIGINAL MANUFACTURER, MODEL NUMBER AND SERIAL
NUMBER OF THE BOAT, IF KNOWN, BE PLACED ON THE BOAT REGISTRATION
CERTIFICATE; TO BRING FORWARD SECTION 59-21-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE
OF 1972, FOR PURPOSES OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENT; AND FOR RELATED

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 **SECTION 1.** All privately owned, recreational boats
- 13 manufactured before January 1, 1965, that are registered with the
- 14 Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks shall be
- 15 exempt from the three (3) year registration renewal requirement as
- 16 provided in Section 59-21-19. Such boats shall have the boat
- 17 registration number placed on the inside of the boat, and the
- 18 original manufacturer, model number and serial number of the boat,
- 19 if known, shall be placed on the boat registration certificate.
- SECTION 2. Section 59-21-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 21 brought forward as follows:

PURPOSES.

- 22 59-21-19. (1) The certificate of number shall be
- 23 pocket-size, approximately two and one-half inches (2-1/2") by
- 24 three and one-half inches (3-1/2"), and water resistant.
- 25 (2) Pending the issuance of the original certificate of
- 26 number, the owner of the vessel may be furnished a temporary
- 27 certificate of number valid for sixty (60) days from the date of
- 28 issue. This temporary certificate shall be carried on board when
- 29 the vessel is being operated.
- 30 (3) Each applicant for an original or transfer certificate
- 31 of number, who is entitled to issuance thereof, shall be issued a
- 32 certificate for a period of three (3) years from the last day of
- 33 the month of receipt of the original or transfer certificate.
- 34 This subsection shall not apply to the certificate of number of a
- 35 livery boat.
- 36 (4) The certificate of number of a livery boat shall be
- 37 plainly marked "livery boat." The description of the motor and
- 38 type of fuel will be omitted from the certificate of number in any
- 39 case where the motor is not rented with the boat. Original and
- 40 renewal certificates of number of a livery boat shall be valid for
- 41 a period of three (3) years and shall expire at midnight on June
- 42 30.
- 43 (5) Numbers and certificates of number awarded boats
- 44 operated by manufacturers and dealers may be transferred from one
- 45 (1) boat to another. In lieu of the description, the word
- 46 "manufacturer" or "dealer", as appropriate, will be plainly marked

- 47 on each certificate. The manufacturer or dealer may have the
- 48 number awarded printed upon or attached to a removable sign or
- 49 signs to be temporarily mounted upon or attached to the boat being
- 50 demonstrated or tested so long as the display meets the
- 51 requirements of Section 59-21-9.
- 52 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 53 and after July 1, 2022.
