HOUSE BILL NO. 1339

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF 2 STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING 3 ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE WILLIAM F. WINTER AND JACK REED, SR., 4 TEACHER LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 9 of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of granting loan repayment awards under the William F. Winter and 10 11 Jack Reed, Sr., Teacher Loan Repayment Program established under 12 Section 37-106-36, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year 13 beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023....\$4,000,000.00. 14 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be in

addition to the funds provided to the Board of Trustees of State 15 16 Institutions of Higher Learning in the annual appropriation to the 17 board for the support and maintenance of financial aid scholarship, loan and grant programs and the Mississippi Office of 18 Student Financial Aid for fiscal year 2023, for the purpose of 19 H. 20 increasing the loan repayment awards described in Section 1 above 21 the level provided during fiscal year 2022.

SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

28 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 29 and after July 1, 2022.
