## HOUSE BILL NO. 1383

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT AN INDIVIDUAL FROM OPERATING A SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT UNLESS THE AIRCRAFT HAS BEEN REGISTERED WITH THE CRIMINAL INFORMATION CENTER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; TO REQUIRE A RETAILER WHO SELLS A SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT TO REGISTER 5 THE AIRCRAFT WITH THE CRIMINAL INFORMATION CENTER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY BEFORE THE PURCHASE TRANSACTION IS 7 COMPLETE; TO PROVIDE CERTAIN REGISTRATION AND IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR UNMANNED AIRCRAFTS AND UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS; 8 9 TO PROVIDE THAT THE LICENSE OF A RETAILER WHO FAILS TO REGISTER A SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT WITH THE CRIMINAL INFORMATION CENTER OF 10 11 THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY UPON PURCHASE OF THE AIRCRAFT 12 SHALL BE REVOKED; TO AMEND SECTION 97-47-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF DELIVERING OR ATTEMPTING TO DELIVER CONTRABAND IN THE FORM OF ANY CONTROLLED 14 1.5 SUBSTANCE OR OTHER ILLEGAL DRUGS USING AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM 16 TO A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY PROPERTY OR ADJACENT PROPERTY SHALL BE 17 SENTENCED TO AN ADDITIONAL TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IN THE CUSTODY OF 18 THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR FIVE YEARS; AND FOR RELATED 19 PURPOSES.

- 20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 21 SECTION 1. (1) No individual may operate a small unmanned
- 22 aircraft unless the aircraft has been registered with the Criminal
- 23 Information Center of the Department of Public Safety.
- 24 (2) A retailer who sells a small unmanned aircraft to a
- 25 purchaser shall register the aircraft with the Criminal

- 26 Information Center of the Department of Public Safety before the
- 27 purchase transaction is complete.
- 28 (3) To register a small unmanned aircraft, the retailer
- 29 shall provide the purchaser's information as required by Section 2
- 30 of this act to the department in a manner as prescribed by the
- 31 department. Upon submission of this information, the department
- 32 shall issue a Certificate of Aircraft Registration to the
- 33 purchaser.
- 34 (4) For purposes of this act, "purchaser" means a buyer in
- 35 possession, a bailee, a lessee of a small unmanned aircraft under
- 36 a contract of conditional sale, and the assignee of that person.
- 37 (5) A Certificate of Aircraft Registration issued under this
- 38 section expires three (3) years after the date of issue, unless it
- 39 is renewed.
- 40 (6) The holder of a Certificate of Aircraft Registration
- 41 must renew the certificate by verifying, in a form and manner
- 42 prescribed by the department, that the information provided in
- 43 Section 2 of this act is accurate. If there has been a change in
- 44 the information provided, the holder of the certificate shall
- 45 provide updated information to the department.
- 46 (7) Each Certificate of Aircraft Registration issued by the
- 47 department is effective, unless it has been revoked, canceled,
- 48 expired, or the ownership is transferred, until one of the
- 49 following events occurs:

50 (a	The	small	unmanned	aircraft	is	totally	destroyed
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- 51 or
- 52 (b) Thirty (30) days have elapsed since the death of
- 53 the holder of the Certificate of Aircraft Registration.
- 54 **SECTION 2.** (1) A retailer shall submit the following
- 55 information to the Criminal Information Center of the Department
- of Public Safety for a Certificate of Aircraft Registration to be
- 57 issued to a purchaser:
- 58 (a) Legal name of the purchaser, and, for a purchaser
- 59 other than an individual, the name of the authorized
- 60 representative applying for a Certificate of Aircraft
- 61 Registration;
- (b) Physical address of the purchaser, and, for a
- 63 purchaser other than an individual, the physical address of the
- 64 authorized representative. If the purchaser or authorized
- 65 representative cannot receive mail at a physical address, then a
- 66 mailing address must be provided;
- 67 (c) Email address of the purchaser, or, for a purchaser
- 68 other than an individual, the email address of the authorized
- 69 representative;
- 70 (d) Telephone number of the purchaser, and, for a
- 71 purchaser other than an individual, the telephone number of the
- 72 authorized representative;
- 73 (e) The aircraft manufacturer and model name;

74	(f)	For	anv	standard	remote	identification	unmanned
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- 75 aircraft, the serial number issued by the manufacturer of the
- 76 unmanned aircraft. The serial number provided in an application
- 77 must not be listed on more than one Certificate of Aircraft
- 78 Registration at the same time.
- 79 (q) For any unmanned aircraft equipped with a remote
- 80 identification broadcast module, the serial number issued by the
- 81 manufacturer of the remote identification broadcast module. A
- 82 purchaser may submit the serial number of more than one remote
- 83 identification broadcast module as part of the application for
- 84 aircraft registration. The serial number of a remote
- 85 identification broadcast module provided in the application must
- 86 not be listed on more than one Certificate of Aircraft
- 87 Registration at the same time; and
- 88 (h) Any other information as required by the
- 89 department.
- 90 (2) The purchaser's information provided in this section
- 91 must be submitted to the department through an Internet-based
- 92 small unmanned aircraft registration system in a manner prescribed
- 93 by the department. The department will issue a Certificate of
- 94 Aircraft Registration to the purchaser upon completion of the
- 95 application requirements provided in this section.
- 96 (3) The holder of a Certificate of Aircraft Registration
- 97 must ensure that the information provided under this section
- 98 remains accurate, and must update the information using the

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99 v	web-based	small	unmanned	aircraft	registration	system	within
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- 100 fourteen (14) calendar days of the following:
- 101 (a) A change in the information provided under this
- 102 section; or
- 103 (b) When aircraft registration requires cancellation
- 104 for any reason, including sale, transfer, destruction or export.
- 105 **SECTION 3.** The license of a retailer who fails to register a
- 106 small unmanned aircraft with the Criminal Information Center of
- 107 the Department of Public Safety upon purchase of the aircraft
- 108 shall be revoked.
- SECTION 4. Section 97-47-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 110 amended as follows:
- 97-47-9. (1) Any person who is convicted under Section
- 112 97-47-5(a) shall be quilty of a misdemeanor, punishable up to one
- 113 (1) year in prison or a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars
- (\$1,000.00) for the first offense or both.
- 115 (2) Any person convicted under Section 97-47-5(b) shall be
- 116 guilty of a felony, punishable by a term of no less than three (3)
- 117 years and no more than fifteen (15) years in the State
- 118 Penitentiary or a fine not to exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars
- 119 (\$25,000.00), or both.
- 120 (3) Except to the extent that a greater minimum sentence is
- 121 otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any person who
- is convicted under Section 97-47-5(b) for delivering or

L23	attempting to deliver contraband in the form of any controlled
L24	substances as defined in Section 41-29-105(f) or other illegal
L25	drugs, using an unmanned aircraft system, to a correctional
L26	facility property or adjacent property, shall, in addition to the
L27	punishment provided for in subsection (2) of this section, be
L28	sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the custody of
L29	the Department of Corrections for five (5) years, which sentence
L30	shall not be reduced or suspended.
L31	SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
L32	and after July 1, 2022.
