HOUSE BILL NO. 1407

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-26-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BY THE LEGISLATURE TO THE CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTERS FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-26-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-26-11. (1) There is created in the State Treasury a
- 8 special fund to be known as the Children's Advocacy Centers Fund,
- 9 which shall be administered by the Office of the Attorney General.
- 10 The purpose of the fund shall be for training forensic
- 11 interviewers in child abuse and child sexual abuse cases, training
- 12 law enforcement officers and prosecutors about child abuse cases,
- 13 expanding the number of Children's Advocacy Centers of Mississippi
- 14 to underserved areas, and other related purposes. Monies in the
- 15 fund shall be expended by the Attorney General, upon appropriation
- 16 by the Legislature. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
- 17 subject to fiscal-year limitations, and shall consist of:

- 20 year, beginning with the 2023 fiscal year, for the purposes of
- 21 funding the Children's Advocacy Centers of Mississippi;
- 22 (b) The interest accruing to the fund;
- 23 (c) Monies received under the provisions of Section
- 24 99-19-73;
- 25 (d) Monies received from the federal government;
- 26 (e) Donations; and
- 27 (f) Monies received from such other sources as may be
- 28 provided by law.
- 29 (2) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund to
- 30 be known as the Mississippi Foster Care Fund, which shall be
- 31 administered by the Department of Child Protection Services. The
- 32 purpose of the fund shall be for supporting the services directly
- 33 provided to foster families and foster children by programs,
- 34 persons or entities pursuant to contracts and grants that comply
- 35 with Mississippi law, and for other related purposes. Monies in
- 36 the fund shall be expended by the department, upon appropriation
- 37 by the Legislature, only for the purposes stated in this
- 38 subsection, and only in such amounts as then exist in the fund.
- 39 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal-year
- 40 limitations, and shall consist of:
- 41 (a) Monies appropriated by the Legislature for the
- 42 purposes of funding the Mississippi Foster Care Fund;

- 44 (c) Monies received under the provisions of Section
- 45 99-19-73 for the Mississippi Foster Care Fund, ninety percent
- 46 (90%) of which shall be used directly for supporting the services
- 47 directly provided to foster families and foster children by
- 48 programs, persons or entities pursuant to contracts and grants
- 49 that comply with Mississippi law, and no more than ten percent
- 50 (10%) of which shall be used for administrative purposes;
- 51 (d) Monies received from the federal government;
- 52 (e) Donations; and
- 53 (f) Monies received from such other sources as may be
- 54 provided by law.
- 55 (3) From and after July 1, 2016, the expenses of the
- 56 Children's Advocacy Centers Fund Program shall be defrayed by
- 57 appropriation from the State General Fund, and all user charges
- 58 and fees authorized under this section shall be deposited into the
- 59 State General Fund as authorized by law and as determined by the
- 60 State Fiscal Officer.
- 61 (4) From and after July 1, 2016, no state agency shall
- 62 charge another state agency a fee, assessment, rent or other
- 63 charge for services or resources received by authority of this
- 64 section.
- 65 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after July 1, 2022.
