## HOUSE BILL NO. 1419

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE TERMS "POLITICAL SUBDIVISION" AND "STATE AGENCY"; TO REQUIRE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO PROVIDE A WRITTEN 3 REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND EACH MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT 5 IDENTIFIES RULES ADOPTED BY ANY FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AGENCY DURING 6 THE PREVIOUS MONTH THAT RELATES TO CERTAIN INFORMATION, WAS 7 ADOPTED IN RESPONSE TO AN EXECUTIVE ORDER BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE 8 UNITED STATES, VIOLATES THE RIGHTS GUARANTEED TO THE CITIZENS OF 9 THE UNITED STATES BY THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION, AND PROVIDES 10 THE STATUS OF ANY LAWSUIT FILED AGAINST THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT 11 RELATING TO A RULE IDENTIFIED BY SUCH REPORT OR THAT A COURT HAS 12 FOUND TO VIOLATE THE RIGHTS GUARANTEED TO THE CITIZENS OF THE 13 UNITED STATES BY THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION; TO PROHIBIT STATE AND LOCAL ENTITIES FROM COOPERATING WITH CERTAIN ACTS OF THE 14 1.5 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THAT VIOLATE THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION; 16 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 18 SECTION 1. For purposes of this act, the following words and
- 19 terms shall have the following meanings, unless the context
- 20 clearly indicates otherwise:
- 21 (a) "Political subdivision" means any county,
- municipality, district, instrumentality of the state, public 22
- 23 corporation, commission, board, agency, authority, public body, or
- 24 other public entity responsible for governmental activities in
- 25 geographic areas smaller than that of the state.

26	(b)	"State	agency"	means	any	agency,	department,

- 27 institution, board, commission, council, office, bureau, division,
- 28 committee or subcommittee of the state.
- 29 **SECTION 2.** (1) On the last day of each month, the Attorney
- 30 General shall provide a written report to the Governor, Lieutenant
- 31 Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and each member
- 32 of the Legislature that:
- 33 (a) Identifies each rule adopted by a federal
- 34 government agency during the previous month that:
- 35 (i) Relates to:
- 1. Pandemics or other health emergencies;
- 37 2. The regulation of natural resources,
- 38 including coal and oil;
- 39 3. The regulation of the agriculture
- 40 industry;
- 4. The use of land;
- 42 5. The regulation of the financial sector as
- 43 it relates to environmental, social, or governance standards;
- 44 6. The regulation of the constitutional right
- 45 to keep and bear arms; or
- 7. The free exercise of religion, including
- 47 the congregating of religious practitioners;
- 48 (ii) Was adopted in response to an executive order
- 49 by the President of the United States; or

50	(iii) Violates the rights guaranteed to the
51	citizens of the United States by the United States Constitution;

53	(b) Provides the status of any lawsuit filed against
54	the federal government relating to a rule identified by any report
55	prepared under this act, including whether a court has found the
56	rule to violate the rights guaranteed to the citizens of the
57	United States by the United States Constitution.
58	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a
59	state agency or political subdivision of the state shall not
60	cooperate with a federal government agency in implementing any
61	agency rule that has been found by a court to violate the rights
62	guaranteed to the citizens of the United States by the United
63	States Constitution.
64	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2022.
