1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF THE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME COURT, THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF APPEALS, THE CHANCERY AND CIRCUIT COURT JUDGES, AND THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS, EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1, 2023; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.					
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:					
7	<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 25-3-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is					
8	amended as follows:					
9	25-3-35. (1) The annual salaries of the following judges					
10	are fixed as follows:

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20 There are imposed upon the Supreme Court justices the extra 21 duties of taking all necessary action to promote judicial 22 education in schools, intervention courts, electronic filing and case management systems as developed by the Administrative Office 23 24 of Courts, or such other additional duties as may be assigned by 25 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. For such extra services each justice, from and after January 1, * * * 2023, shall receive 26 27 a sum sufficient to aggregate, per annum, the salaries set forth 28 in this subsection (1).

29 The fixed salaries in this subsection (1) shall be paid from 30 the State General Fund and from the Judicial System Operation Fund created under Section 9-21-45. No less than: One Hundred Fifteen 31 32 Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$115,390.00) of the Chief Justice's salary in this subsection (1), One Hundred Thirteen 33 Thousand One Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$113,190.00) of the salary of 34 35 a presiding justice in this subsection (1), and One Hundred Twelve 36 Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$112,530.00) of the salary of an associate justice in this subsection (1) shall be paid from 37 38 general fund monies; in addition, the Legislature shall 39 appropriate annually from the Judicial System Operation Fund a sum 40 sufficient to increase the salary of the Chief Justice, a presiding justice and an associate justice to the levels set forth 41 42 in this subsection (1).

The fixed salaries as specified in this subsection (1) shall be the exclusive and total compensation which can be reported to

52 Through December 31, 2022:

61 The fixed salaries in this subsection (2) shall be paid from the State General Fund and from the Judicial System Operation Fund 62 63 created under Section 9-21-45. No less than One Hundred Eight 64 Thousand One Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$108,130.00) of the Chief 65 Judge's salary in this subsection (2) shall be paid from general 66 fund monies; in addition, the Legislature shall appropriate annually from the Judicial System Operation Fund a sum sufficient 67 68 to increase the Chief Judge's salary to the level set forth in this subsection (2). No less than One Hundred Five Thousand Fifty 69

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Dollars (\$105,050.00) of the salary of an associate judge in this subsection (2) shall be paid from general fund monies; in addition, the Legislature shall appropriate annually from the Judicial System Operation Fund a sum sufficient to increase the salary of an associate judge to the level set forth in this subsection (2).

The fixed salaries as specified in this subsection (2) shall be the exclusive and total compensation which can be reported to the Public Employees' Retirement System for retirement purposes; however, any judge in office on December 31, 2003, may continue to report his expense allowance as part of his compensation for retirement purposes.

91 In addition to their present official duties, the circuit and

92 chancery judges shall take necessary action to promote judicial 93 education in schools, intervention courts, electronic filing and 94 case management systems as developed by the Administrative Office

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95 of Courts, or such other additional duties as may be assigned by 96 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. For such extra services 97 each judge, from and after January 1, * * * 2023, shall receive a 98 sum sufficient to aggregate, per annum, the salaries set forth in 99 this subsection (3).

100 The fixed salaries in this subsection (3) shall be paid from 101 the State General Fund and from the Judicial System Operation Fund created under Section 9-21-45. No less than One Hundred Four 102 103 Thousand One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$104,170.00) of the salary 104 of a chancery or circuit judge in this subsection (3) shall be paid from general fund monies; in addition, the Legislature shall 105 106 appropriate annually from the Judicial System Operation Fund a sum 107 sufficient to increase the salary of a chancery or circuit judge 108 to the levels set forth in this subsection (3).

109 (4) From and after January 1, 2019, and every four (4) years 110 thereafter, the annual salaries of the judges in subsections (1), 111 (2) and (3) shall be fixed at the level of compensation recommended by the State Personnel Board according to the board's 112 113 most recent report on judicial salaries, as required under Section 114 25-9-115, to the extent that sufficient funds are available. The 115 annual salaries fixed in accordance with this subsection (4) shall not become effective until the commencement of the next 116 117 immediately succeeding term of office.

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(5) The Supreme Court shall prepare a payroll for chancery judges and circuit judges and submit such payroll to the Department of Finance and Administration.

121 (6) The annual salary of the full-time district attorneys122 shall be:

130 The annual salary of the full-time legal assistants (7)131 shall be not less than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) nor more than eighty percent (80%) of the salary of the district 132 133 attorney for legal assistants who have been licensed to practice 134 law for five (5) years or less; eighty-five percent (85%) of the salary of the district attorney for legal assistants who have been 135 136 licensed to practice law for at least five (5) years but less than 137 fifteen (15) years; and ninety percent (90%) of the salary of the 138 district attorney for legal assistants who have been licensed to 139 practice law for at least fifteen (15) years or more.

140SECTION 2.This act shall take effect and be in force from141and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.

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
