HOUSE BILL NO. 1427 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER FUNDS 2 OUT OF THE CORONAVIRUS STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND TO THE SPECIAL 3 FUND CREATED BY THIS ACT; TO CREATE THE "MISSISSIPPI LAW 4 ENFORCEMENT AND FIRE FIGHTERS PREMIUM PAY FUND" AS A SPECIAL FUND 5 IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 6 PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO LAW 7 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND FIRE FIGHTERS AS PREMIUM PAY FOR THEIR EFFORTS DURING THE COVID-19; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The federal COVID-19 public health emergency 11 continues to create significant exposure and risk to law 12 enforcement officers and fire fighters in the State of 13 Mississippi. American Rescue Plan Act funds are specifically 14 targeted toward assisting with premium pay for such public safety

15 workers. The funds provided in this act are necessary

16 expenditures related to COVID-19, the purpose of which is to

17 provide law enforcement officers and fire fighters premium pay for

18 their heightened risk during the ongoing federal COVID-19 public

19 health emergency.

20 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Upon the effective date of this act, the State 21 Fiscal Officer shall transfer the sum of <u>Twenty-eight Million</u>

H. B. No. 1427 G1/2 22/HR26/R1716PH PAGE 1 (RF\KW) 22 <u>Dollars (\$28,000,000.00)</u> from the Coronavirus State Fiscal 23 Recovery Fund to the Mississippi Law Enforcement and Fire Fighters 24 Premium Pay Fund created by Section 3 of this act.

25 SECTION 3. (1)There is created in the State Treasury a 26 special fund to be designated as the "Mississippi Law Enforcement 27 and Fire Fighters Premium Pay Fund," which shall consist of funds made available by the Legislature in any manner and funds from any 28 29 other source designated for deposit into such fund. The fund 30 shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and 31 special fund, separate and apart from the General Fund of the 32 state. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any 33 34 investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fund 35 shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. Monies in the fund 36 shall be used by the Department of Public Safety, upon 37 appropriation by the Legislature, for the purposes provided in 38 this section. Monies in the fund shall be disbursed in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other 39 40 criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United 41 States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from 42 the American Rescue Plan Act. Monies in the fund shall be 43 disbursed by the Department of Public Safety to provide premium pay to certain law enforcement officers and fire fighters in the 44 State of Mississippi. 45

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46 (2)The Department of Public Safety shall distribute the 47 monies in the special fund in accordance with the following: One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of premium pay 48 (a) 49 shall be paid to each eligible individual. 50 Eligible individuals are all certified, full-time (b) 51 and part-time law enforcement officers and certified, full-time 52 and part-time fire fighters who are serving in the State of 53 Mississippi on the effective date of this act, except those 54 excluded under paragraph (c) of this subsection, and all volunteer 55 fire fighters registered with the State of Mississippi or a political subdivision thereof on a volunteer fire fighting status 56

57 who have served as a fire fighter in the State of Mississippi from

58 January 1, 2020, through the effective date of this act. The

59 <u>Commissioner of Insurance shall prescribe the criteria for</u>

60 volunteer fire fighters to be an eligible individual under this

61 paragraph. If a person is an eligible individual in more than one

62 (1) position covered under this paragraph, that person will only

63 <u>be eligible for one (1) payment of premium pay under paragraph (a)</u>

64 of this subsection.

(c) Any law enforcement officer who received hazard pay
from the Governor's discretionary funds authorized by the
Legislature from the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic
Security Act is not eligible to receive monies under this act.

No. 1427 **~ OFFICIAL ~** 22/HR26/R1716PH PAGE 3 (RF\KW) entities that, before the effective date of this act, paid premium pay to law enforcement officers and firefighters employed by them from funds received under the federal American Rescue Plan Act, to reimburse those governmental entities for not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of the amount of premium pay that the governmental entity paid to each recipient.

(3) The Department of Finance and Administration and the Department of Audit shall have all powers necessary for the implementation of this section.

80 If the Office of Inspector General of the United States (4)81 Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 82 83 from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds established by the American Rescue Plan Act (a) determines that 84 the Department of Public Safety or recipient has expended or 85 86 otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the Department of 87 Public Safety under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations 88 89 and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, by the 90 United States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of 91 monies from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds 92 established by the American Rescue Plan Act, and (b) the State of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of 93 those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 94 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the Department of 95

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96 Public Safety or recipient, then the Department of Safety or 97 recipient, as the case may be, that expended or otherwise used 98 those funds improperly shall be required to pay the amount of 99 those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to the 100 federal government.

101 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 102 and after <u>July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after</u> 103 <u>June 30, 2022</u>.
