HOUSE BILL NO. 1534

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SUNFLOWER 2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE SUNFLOWER COUNTY 3 MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE COUNSELING SERVICE, INC.; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Sunflower 7 County, Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to contribute an amount not to exceed Forty Thousand Dollars 8 9 (\$40,000.00) annually, out of any available funds of the county, 10 to the Sunflower County Ministerial Alliance Counseling Service, Inc., a 501(c)(3) corporation, that will administer the daily 11 12 operations of the Sunflower County Transition Center, which is a county facility that primarily addresses the needs of the homeless 13 14 population within the county.

15 (2) This section shall be repealed from and after July16 1, 2026.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18 and after its passage.
