23 SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 24 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State 25 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer 26 27 shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 28 29 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 30 and after July 1, 2022.
