HOUSE BILL NO. 1618

1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PAT HARRISON WATERWAY 3 DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any 6 funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the 7 8 Pat Harrison Waterway District, for the purpose of defraying the 9 expenses of the district for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023..... 10 11\$ 5,600,234.00. 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 13 14 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 15 16 Part Time.... 20 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 17 0 Part Time..... 18 0

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19 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 20 responsibility to make certain that funds required for "Personal 21 Services" for Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2023 22 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions 23 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 budget by the 24 Mississippi Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's personal services appropriation, which shall be published 25 26 by the State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel 27 Board shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll 28 costs based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility 29 of the agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures 30 for Fiscal Year 2023 do not exceed the data provided by the 31 Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 32 projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions 33 shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception 34 of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.

35 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 36 37 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 38 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 39 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 40 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 41 42 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 43 appropriated level.

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None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

52 Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of 53 funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered 54 under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation 55 Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the 56 funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the 57 minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 58 SECTION 3. 59 Pat Harrison Waterway District shall maintain complete accounting 60 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 61 62 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 63 2022. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 64 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to 65 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 66 67 during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request process.

It is the intention of the Legislature that 69 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 70 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 71 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 72 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 73 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 74 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 75 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

83 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 84 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 85 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 86 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 87 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 88 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 89 actions contrary to this provision.

90 SECTION 7. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 91 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 92 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

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93 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2022.

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
