- 19 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 20 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 21

- 55 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 56 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 57 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 58 actions contrary to this provision.
- 59 **SECTION 8.** The money appropriated under the provisions of
- 60 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
- 61 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 62 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2022.
