9	Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending		
10	June 30, 2023	\$ 3,373,928.00.	
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
12	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

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18 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 19 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

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43 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget44 Committee for Fiscal Year 2024.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 45 46 Office of State Public Defender shall maintain complete accounting 47 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 48 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 49 2022. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 50 51 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to 52 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 53 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 54 during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request process.

55 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 56 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 57 58 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 59 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 60 61 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 62 made without competitive bids.

63 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 64 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 65 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 66 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 67 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

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SECTION 7. Of the funds provided in Section 1, Two Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$278,500.00) shall be provided for the Indigent Parental Representation for the purpose of contracting with trained and certified attorneys to represent indigent parents or guardians in abuse, neglect or termination of parental rights proceedings as provided under Sections 43-21-201 and 99-18-13, Mississippi Code of 1972.

77 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 80 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 81 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 82 83 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2022.
