HOUSE BILL NO. 1641

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
2 HINDS COUNTY TO ASSIST IN PAYING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE  
3 CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF TWO WATER WELLS AND RELATED TOWERS  
4 TO SERVE A NEW DETENTION CENTER TO BE CONSTRUCTED BY THE COUNTY  
5 NEAR MCDOWELL ROAD AND GALLATIN STREET IN THE CITY OF JACKSON, FOR  
6 THE FISCAL YEAR 2023.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be  
9 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus  
10 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the  
11 Board of Supervisors of Hinds County, Mississippi, to assist in  
12 paying costs associated with the construction and development of  
13 two (2) water wells and related towers to serve a new detention  
14 center to be constructed by Hinds County near McDowell Road and  
15 Gallatin Street in the City of Jackson, Mississippi, for the  
16 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023 .....  
17 .....\$ 20,000,000.00.

18 **SECTION 2.** (1) As used in this section and Section 3 of  
19 this act, the term "board" means the Board of Supervisors of Hinds  
20 County, Mississippi.



21           (2) The board shall not disburse any funds appropriated  
22 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an  
23 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in  
24 the board's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures  
25 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as  
26 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of  
27 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules,  
28 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or  
29 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of  
30 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not  
31 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in  
32 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds,  
33 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal  
34 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In  
35 addition, the board shall ensure that all funds appropriated under  
36 this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit Act (31  
37 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the Uniform  
38 Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal controls,  
39 Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient  
40 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit  
41 requirements.

42           **SECTION 3.** (1) As a condition of receiving and expending  
43 the funds appropriated to the board under this act, the board  
44 shall certify to the Department of Finance and Administration that  
45 each expenditure of the funds appropriated to the board under this



46 act complies with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations  
47 and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the  
48 United States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of  
49 monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established  
50 by ARPA.

51 (2) If the Office of Inspector General of the United States  
52 Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of  
53 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies  
54 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by  
55 ARPA (a) determines that the board or recipient has expended or  
56 otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the board under  
57 this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the  
58 guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as  
59 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department  
60 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus  
61 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State  
62 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any  
63 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined  
64 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the board or  
65 recipient, then the board or recipient that expended or otherwise  
66 used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the amount of  
67 those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to the  
68 federal government.

69 **SECTION 4.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid  
70 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State



71 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants  
72 issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer  
73 shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
74 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

75         **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
76 and after July 1, 2022.
