HOUSE BILL NO. 1650

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF
2 HEALTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING UPGRADES AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS
3 TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE AT THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENTS, FOR THE
4 FISCAL YEAR 2023.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of Health
9 for the purpose of making upgrades and other improvements to the
10 infrastructure at the county health departments, as provided in
11 Section 2 of this act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022,
12 and ending June 30, 2023\$ 49,692,200.00.

13 **SECTION 2.** The funds appropriated under Section 1 of this
14 act shall be expended by the department for the following
15 infrastructure needs at the county health departments:

16 (a) New county health department buildings.....

18 (b) District office buildings.....\$ 9,000,000.00.

31 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
32 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
33 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
34 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
35 her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
36 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

37 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
38 and after July 1, 2022.
