HOUSE BILL NO. 1703

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES 2 OF THE TOWN OF JUMPERTOWN TO ASSIST IN PAYING COSTS ASSOCIATED 3 WITH THE REPAIR AND REHABILITATION OF AND UPGRADES AND 4 IMPROVEMENTS TO FOUR OF THE TOWN'S WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM 5 PUMPING STATIONS AND RELATED FACILITIES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus 9 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the 10 governing authorities of the Town of Jumpertown, Mississippi, to assist in paying costs associated with the repair and 11 12 rehabilitation of and upgrades and improvements to four (4) of the town's wastewater collection system pumping stations and related 13 14 facilities, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending 15 June 30, 2023.....\$ 200,000.00. SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section and Section 3 of 16 17 this act, the term "town" means the Town of Jumpertown, Mississippi. 18

No. 1703 22/HR12/R2110 PAGE 1 (RF\AM) 19 (2)The town shall not disburse any funds appropriated under 20 this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an 21 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in 22 the town's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures 23 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 24 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 25 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 26 27 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 28 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not 29 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in 30 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, 31 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 32 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In 33 addition, the town shall ensure that all funds appropriated under 34 this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit Act (31 35 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal controls, 36 37 Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient 38 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 39 requirements.

40 SECTION 3. (1) As a condition of receiving and expending 41 the funds appropriated to the town under this act, the town shall 42 certify to the Department of Finance and Administration that each 43 expenditure of the funds appropriated to the town under this act

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44 complies with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or 45 other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United 46 States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from 47 the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.

48 (2)If the Office of Inspector General of the United States 49 Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 50 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 51 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 52 ARPA (a) determines that the town or recipient has expended or 53 otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the town under 54 this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the 55 quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 56 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 57 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 58 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State 59 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any 60 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined were expended or otherwise used improperly by the town or 61 62 recipient, then the town or recipient that expended or otherwise 63 used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the amount of 64 those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to the 65 federal government.

66 **SECTION 4.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 67 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State 68 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants

This act shall take effect and be in force from 73 and after July 1, 2022.
