HOUSE BILL NO. 1719

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO ANGELA
2 PORTER-WILLIAMS OF AMITE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED
3 PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
6 completely restored to Angela Porter-Williams of Amite County,
7 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
8 conviction for the crime of embezzlement on September 19, 2006, in
9 Pike County, Mississippi, for which she was sentenced to serve six
10 (6) months on house arrest followed by five (5) years probation.

11 She was released to probation on March 18, 2007, and
12 discharged from probation on June 23, 2008. She completed all
13 terms and conditions of her sentence. The Legislature is informed
14 that she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and
15 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after July 1, 2022.
