## HOUSE BILL NO. 1729

AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO ANTHONY LEROY WALLACE OF HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Anthony Leroy Wallace of Harrison County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector when he was
- 7 sentenced on August 9, 1999, as a result of his conviction for the
- 8 crime of robbery in Harrison County, Mississippi, for which he was
- 9 sentenced to four (4) years probation. His probation was revoked
- 10 on June 10, 2002, and he was sentenced to serve a term of ten (10)
- 11 years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- 12 On July 2, 2002, he was convicted on two (2) counts of felony DUI
- 13 for a term of one (1) year for each count to run consecutively.
- He was released on November 15, 2007, and discharged on July
- 15 7, 2009. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 16 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 17 lawful manner.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

19 and after its passage.
