HOUSE BILL NO. 1730

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO MR. RAY FERRELL OF 2 HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and 4 completely restored to Mr. Ray Ferrell of Harrison County, 5 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his 7 conviction for the crime of burglary on July 16, 1985, in Harrison 8 County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to serve three (3) 9 years probation.

He completed all terms and conditions of his sentence and was discharged on May 20, 1987. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 15 and after its passage.
