## HOUSE BILL NO. 1731

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DEBORAH LEDBETTER OF HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Ms. Deborah Ledbetter of Hinds County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction for the crime of forgery credit card in Hinds County,
- 8 Mississippi, on March 15, 1996, for which she was sentenced to
- 9 serve two (2) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department
- 10 of Corrections, two (2) years suspended with one (1) year
- 11 supervised probation. Upon violation of her probation, it was
- 12 revoked. On January 26, 2001, she was convicted for the crime of
- 13 forgery credit card in Hinds County, Mississippi, for which she
- 14 was sentenced to serve one (1) year in the custody of the
- 15 Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- 16 She completed all terms and conditions of her sentence and
- 17 was discharged on June 22, 2001. The Legislature is informed that

- 18 she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and honorable
- 19 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after its passage.
