HOUSE BILL NO. 1736

AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO EDNA BARNETT OF JONES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Ms. Edna Barnett of Jones County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction for the crime of shoplifting on August 19, 1993, in
- 8 Jones County, Mississippi, for which she was sentenced to serve
- 9 three (3) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 10 Corrections, with charges to run concurrent with her convictions
- 11 for cocaine-possession. She was released and discharged on March
- 12 25, 1996, but charged on July 17, 2002, for cocaine-possession and
- 13 on September 19, 2006, in Jones County, Mississippi, for the crime
- 14 of shoplifting which she was sentenced to four (4) years in the
- 15 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections, following
- one (1) year on probation. She was released to probation on
- 17 November 16, 2008. On September 29, 2011, she was convicted for
- 18 shoplifting in Jones County, Mississippi, for which she was

- 19 sentenced to serve one (1) year, with three (3) years probation.
- 20 Her probation was extended by two (2) years for absconding
- 21 supervision.
- 22 She completed all terms and conditions of all sentences and
- 23 was discharged on April 15, 2019. The Legislature is informed
- 24 that she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and
- 25 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after its passage.
