## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 15

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION MOURNING THE LOSS AND COMMEMORATING  
2 THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF MR. GEORGE SMITH.

3 WHEREAS, it is written in Ecclesiastes 3:1 that "To  
4 everything there is a season and a time for every purpose under  
5 the Heaven," and as such, the immaculate author and finisher of  
6 our soul's destiny summoned the mortal presence of dearly beloved,  
7 Mr. George Smith, to eternal rest, rendering great sorrow and loss  
8 to his family, friends and community; and

9 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi and the entire Mississippi  
10 Gulf Coast community lost a wonderful friend, loving husband and  
11 father and dedicated community leader with the passing of Mr.  
12 Smith, who was born on January 12, 1935, in Gulfport, to the late  
13 Hubert and Mildred Smith, and there is now a hush in our hearts as  
14 we come together to pay our respects to the memory of one who has  
15 been called to join that innumerable heavenly caravan; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Smith was a man of uncompromised faith and a  
17 member of First United Methodist Church in Wiggins, Mississippi,  
18 and he now enjoys the eternal peace described in Luke 2:29, "Lord,



19 now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to  
20 your word"; and

21 WHEREAS, after graduating from Gulfport High School, Mr.  
22 Smith joined an elite fraternity of seamen in the United States  
23 Navy in 1952, and he patriotically served his country in Guam  
24 during the Korean War; and

25 WHEREAS, upon his return from the war, Mr. Smith attended  
26 Perkinston College, now Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College,  
27 where he played football, and William Carey University in  
28 Gulfport, and upon his graduation, he selflessly dedicated his  
29 professional career and numerous years of illustrious public  
30 service and competent guidance to the people in his community; and

31 WHEREAS, Mr. Smith has served as a Gulfport motorcycle  
32 policeman, an Alcohol Beverage Control agent, an assistant sheriff  
33 in Harrison County, a state senator, the Secretary of the Senate  
34 under the leadership of Lieutenant Governor Amy Tuck, the Harrison  
35 County Youth Court Administrator, Tourism Director for Harrison  
36 County and Tourism Director for the State of Mississippi, and he  
37 retired from the Mississippi Department of Transportation in 2015;

39 WHEREAS, after his retirement, Mr. Smith continued his role  
40 of public service when he served as an alderman in Wiggins and as  
41 a board member for the Pat Harrison Waterway District, and in his  
42 spare time, Mr. Smith was an avid outdoorsman, loved watching Ole



43 Miss football and truly enjoyed living a full life on his own  
44 terms; and

45 WHEREAS, Mr. George Smith was a strong, loving and  
46 compassionate husband, father, grandfather, confidante and friend  
47 who touched the lives of all those who crossed his sweet and  
48 charming path, and his warm hugs, positive energy, contagious  
49 laughter and bright smile will be forever cherished by his family,  
50 friends and others who knew him and experienced his greatness; and

51 WHEREAS, though he has traversed life's river to now stand  
52 upon the celestial shores in wonderment of Heaven's grandeur in  
53 glorious reunion with those who transitioned before him, including  
54 his wife, Carol Smith, his parents, Hubert and Mildred Smith, his  
55 son, Mark Smith, and his brother, Larry Smith, the memory of Mr.  
56 Smith, a man held in the highest regard by friends and family as  
57 an inspiring and precious gift from God, will continue to refresh  
58 the hearts and memories of his beloved survivors: children, Susan  
59 Allen (Joey), Julia Threadgill (Ricky) and Brian Cain (Chris);  
60 daughter-in-law, Angie Smith; brother, Richard Smith;  
61 grandchildren, Lauren Parker (Jonathan), Scarlett Bellot, Meghan  
62 Smith, Porter Smith, Carson Thrash (Taylor), Keith Cain, Connor  
63 Cain, Marissa Allen and Whitney Threadgill; 10  
64 great-grandchildren; and a host of other relatives and friends;

81 State of Mississippi:

82 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
83 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
84 THEREIN, That we do hereby mourn the loss and commemorate the life  
85 and legacy of Mr. George Smith, and express deepest sympathy to  
86 his family and friends upon his passing.
