- investigate both the security issues of the January 6 attack as 15
- well as the circumstances leading up to the attack; and 16
- 17 WHEREAS, Representative Bennie G., Thompson from Mississippi,
- was appointed to serve as chairman of this crucially important 18

- 19 committee, and Representative Liz Cheney, from Wyoming, was
- 20 appointed to serve as vice chairman; and

- 31 distinguished committee, with dignity, patriotism and respect for
- 32 the American people; and
