HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 35

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 12A, MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO PROVIDE THAT THE
- 3 MISSISSIPPI COMMISSION ON WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS, ACTING
- 4 THROUGH THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND
- 5 PARKS, SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ENSURE THE
- 6 PEOPLE'S RIGHT TO HUNT, FISH AND HARVEST WILDLIFE.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 8 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 9 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 10 state:
- 11 Amend Section 12, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 12 as follows:
- "Section 12A. (1) The people have the right to hunt, fish
- 14 and harvest wildlife, including by the use of traditional methods,
- 15 subject only to laws and regulations that promote wildlife
- 16 conservation and management and that preserve the future of
- 17 hunting and fishing, as the Legislature may prescribe by general
- 18 law. Public hunting and fishing shall be a preferred means of
- 19 managing and controlling wildlife.

20	(2) The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and
21	Parks, acting through the Mississippi Department of Wildlife,
22	Fisheries and Parks, shall promulgate rules and regulations to
23	ensure the people's right to hunt, fish and harvest wildlife.
24	(3) This section may not be construed to modify any
25	provision of law relating to trespass, property rights, the
26	regulation of commercial activities or the maintenance of levees
27	pursuant to Article 11."
28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That these proposed amendments shall
29	be submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors
30	at an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first
31	Monday of November 2022, as provided by Section 273 of the
32	Constitution and by general law, with the proposed amendment of
33	this resolution being voted on as one amendment since it pertains
34	to one subject.
35	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
36	amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
37	constitutional amendment provides that the Mississippi Commission
38	on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, acting through the Mississippi
39	Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, shall promulgate
40	rules and regulations to ensure the people's right to hunt, fish
41	and harvest wildlife."
