HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 43

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE
2 SCOTT CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL REBELS FOOTBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH JEFF
3 STOCKSTILL FOR WINNING THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES
4 ASSOCIATION CLASS 2A STATE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, the Scott Central High School Rebels Football Team
6 and Head Coach Jeff Stockstill have completed an amazing regular
7 season and reigned supreme throughout the playoffs to win the
8 Mississippi High School Activities Association Class 2A State
9 Football Championship, the only public school football team in the
10 state with a perfect record this season of 15-0; and

11 WHEREAS, the Rebels, who had a remarkable season that was
12 driven by more than just the yearning to succeed, intensely
13 amplified all of their hard work, motivation and audacity, which
14 were so apparent all through the season, for the game that
15 ultimately separated the men from the boys to dominate Leflore
16 County 72-24 and collect the Mississippi High School Activities
17 Association Class 2A Football Championship; and

18 WHEREAS, Sophomore Quarterback Quez Goss ran for 103 yards
19 and two touchdowns and threw for 350 yards and six touchdowns on



20 his way to being named 2A Offensive Player of the Year and Most
21 Valuable Player; and Head Coach Jeff Stockstill was named 2A Coach

27 and Trey Edwards was named Scholar Athlete; and

28 WHEREAS, throughout their season of play, the Rebels, who
29 also won titles in 1999 and 2018, faced off with some of the
30 state's best contenders on the gridiron, but persevered to make
31 their presence and talent known as gladiators of football under
32 the Friday night lights; and

33 WHEREAS, the Scott Central statistics were impressive, and
34 there were outstanding performances by individual players, but the
35 key to this team's consistent success has been the constant team
36 atmosphere and year-round hard work; and

39 Goss, Chandler Powell, Blake Hall, John Brassfield, Tony Johnson
